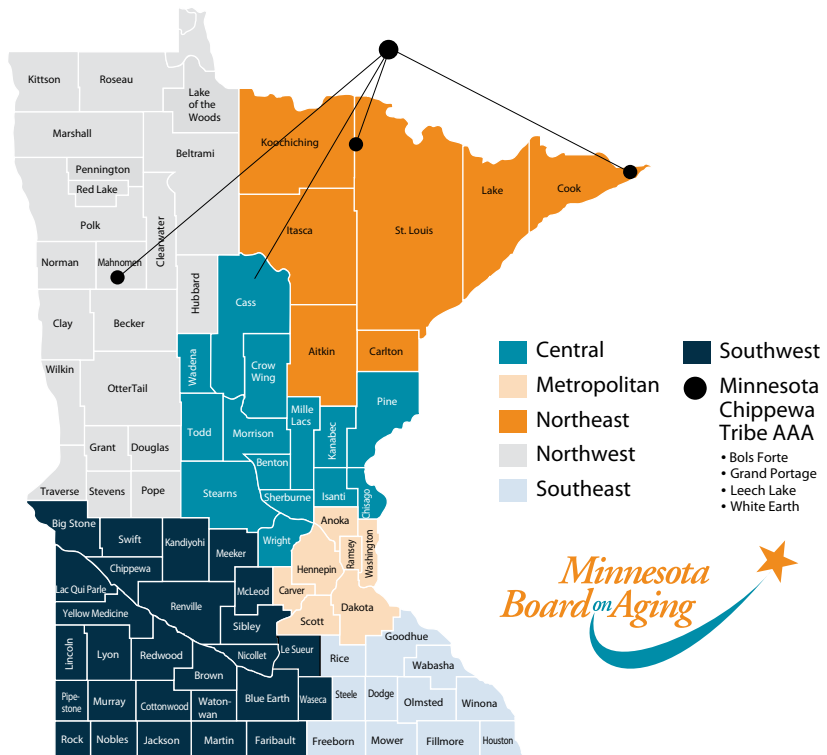

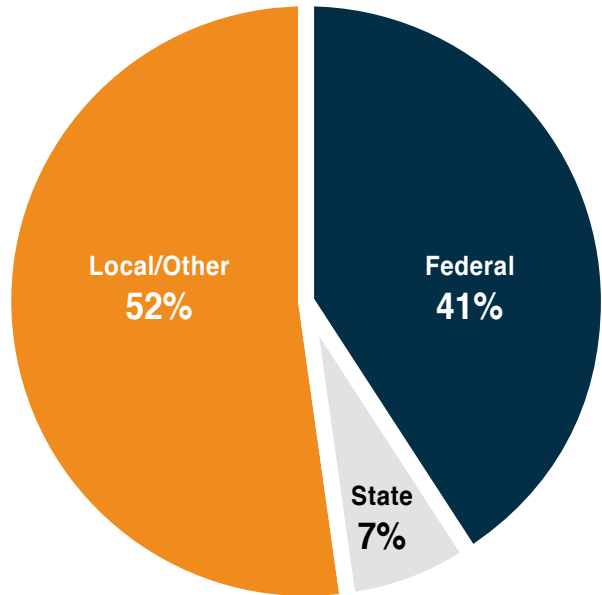

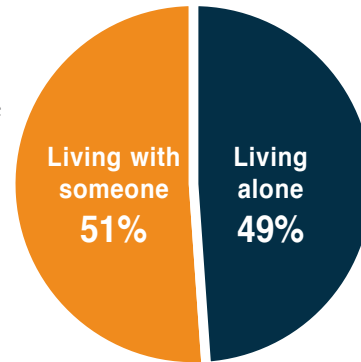

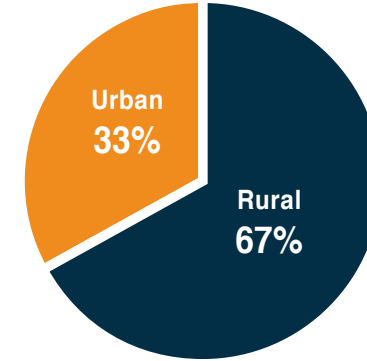
CONSUMERS LIVING ALONE

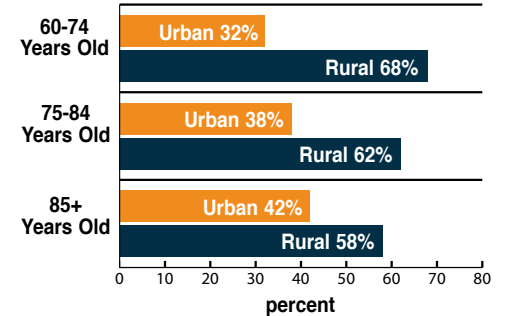


WHERE CONSUMERS LIVE

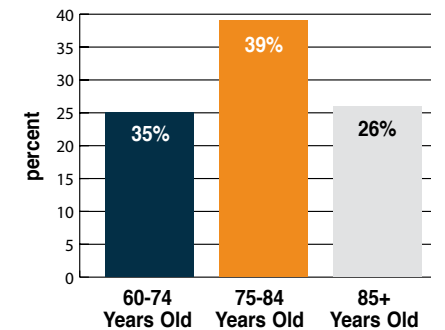
67% of Older Americans Act customers live in rural Minnesota.
