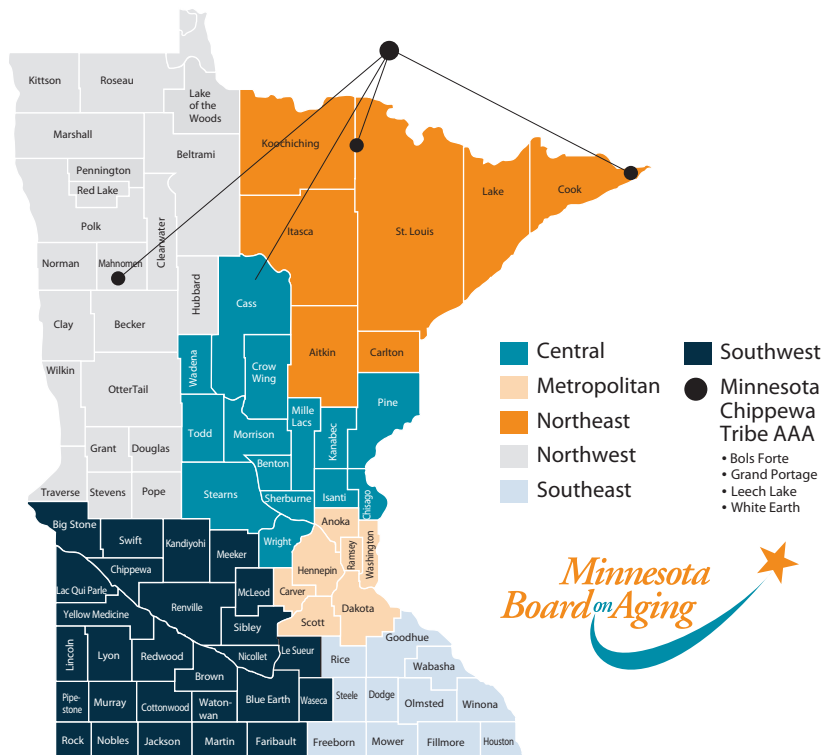

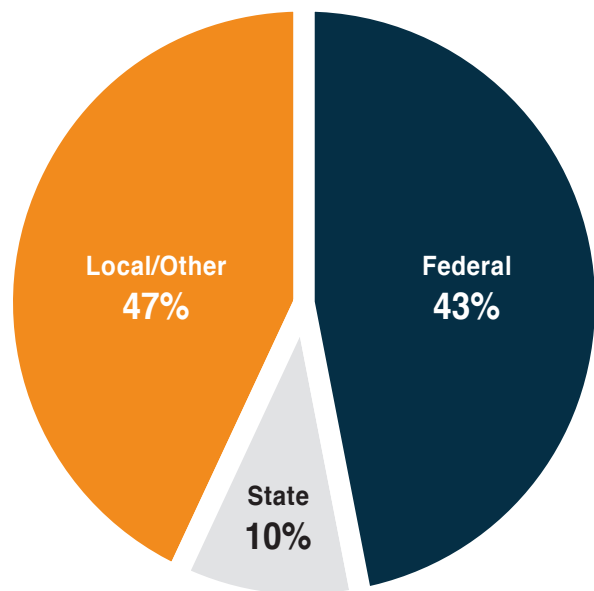

In that role, it has primary responsibility for administering Older Americans Act funding and programs for Minnesota's 930,000 citizens over the age of 60. Each year, the Minnesota Board on Aging provides a comprehensive report of the services provided through the federal Older Americans Act and state of Minnesota funding to the federal Administration on Aging. 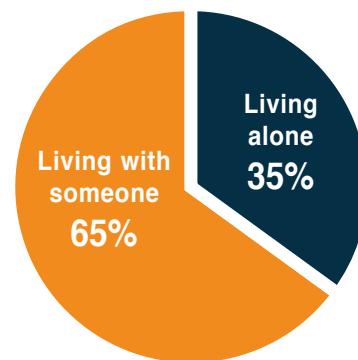

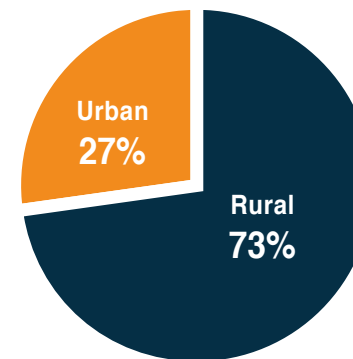
## CONSUMERS LIVING ALONE

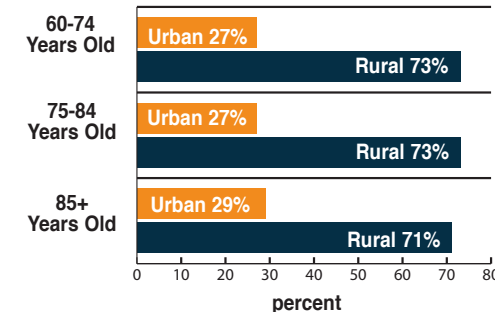


## WHERE CONSUMERS LIVE
